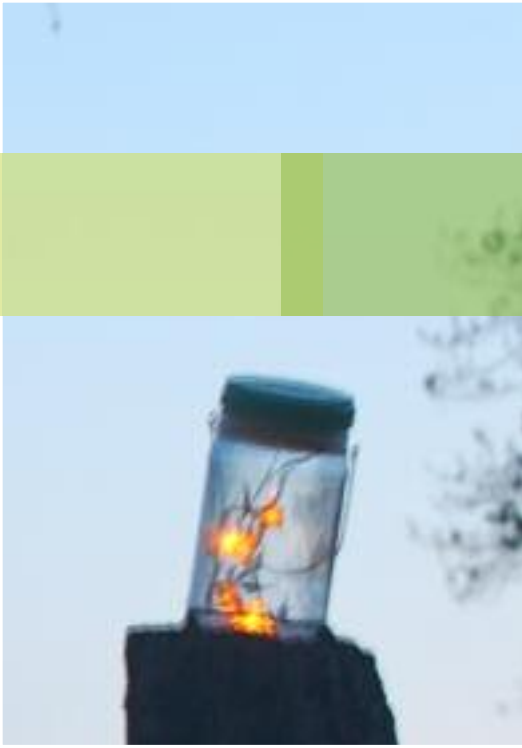


# sharing the gift of nature

In 2008 we “raised our barn” and in 2009 we officially opened the doors of this marvelous Amish-built structure designed to house programs for families whose lives have been forever changed by a diagnosis of cancer.

On the second floor our Mind, Body, Spirit programs have dedicated space to begin to root and grow—to expand into day and night and weekend classes. On the first floor our Kids Circle/Teen Circle programs for children who have a loved one with cancer now have a space that is family-friendly and inviting. There is spacious room for both active and quiet activities, as well as the privacy and security for children to open up and express themselves.


Now that programs are taking up their rightful place in our barn, we are dedicated to moving outwards into nature. Since arriving here in 2003, we have wanted to more actively invite people out of doors. As it often does, serendipity played a hand when three very special projects came to fruition, honoring the memory of three women who died, too early, of cancer: the Firefly Meadow, the Butterfly Garden and the seating area behind the barn.

We know that, in many ways, HopeWell provides the balance to the stress and intensity of the medical world. Nature is an invaluable element of our setting. It is wonderful that we can now invite people to take advantage of our lovely surroundings—whether walking in the meadow, sitting contemplatively by the butterfly garden or gathering around a picnic table.

There are dreams to come, but for now, our barn and the out-of-doors will serve as a meeting place for all of our participants, donors and friends.

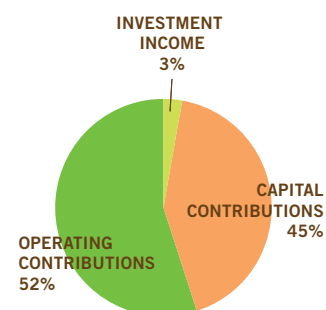

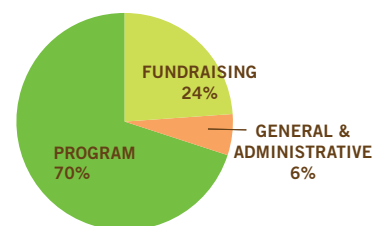

# Programs and Services

HopeWell Cancer Support exists because people with cancer need so much more than medical care. Each month, we offer over 75 program opportunities and services at no charge for cancer patients, their families and loved ones.

Offerings include:

- Support and networking groups
- Programs for children and teens who have a loved one with cancer
- Stress reduction programs (yoga, T'ai Chi, exercise and meditation)
- Educational series with leading health care experts
- Expressive Arts
- Bereavement groups for adults and children
- Information and referral services



## PROGRAM DEVELOPMENTS 2009-10

HopeWell's programming, as a tenet of our values and principles, continues to be responsive to the expressed needs of our participant community. We are pleased to present a few highlights.



### **New Metastatic Breast Group Formed**

In 2009, we recognized that the needs of women with metastatic breast cancer would best be met in a separate support group. With the urging of women themselves and start-up funding, the Metastatic Breast Cancer Group was formed and designed to focus on the unique challenges faced by these women. This special monthly group is designed to provide an opportunity for women with metastatic disease to share information, discuss common concerns and find mutual support.

It was so successful, that in response to the participants' requests, HopeWell began offering the group twice a month to enable more interaction, deepen the support system and encourage the inclusion of more group members. The Metastatic Breast Cancer Support Group is an example of a successful participant-inspired program.



### **A New Option in our Mind, Body, Spirit Series: Qigong**

HopeWell first introduced Sheng Zhen Qigong at our annual "Picnic in July" and the response was overwhelmingly favorable. In response to participant requests and as funding permitted, we started offering it on a more regular basis. As of January 2010, Qigong became a weekly class. It continues to thrive as a very helpful and unique offering and is housed in our barn... except when lovely weather permits and invites an outside class!

### **Taking Stock:**

#### **A Series Focusing on Financial Issues**

Cancer affects every aspect of the life of the individual and their family and an immediate concern during insecure times is economic stability. Money issues may cause additional stress and anxiety. Information and support—often specific to living with cancer—are critical elements in managing financial matters during and after treatment.

The series Taking Stock addresses concerns such as: getting financially organized; personal finance management; health insurance; social security disability; workplace issues; advance directives; and financial powers of attorney. In addition, we offer information on

planned giving to make people fully aware of choices they can make now to be generous in the future. The entire series has been very well-received.

### **Programs for Health Care Professionals**

We have made it a priority to expand our continuing education programs for health-care professionals. At HopeWell, we value our relationships with leaders in psychosocial oncology in the Baltimore region and recognize the important work they do to help individuals with cancer and refer them to invaluable resources in the community.



Our continuing education programs, now offered twice yearly, are designed to provide oncology professionals with opportunities to discuss, explore and examine the impact of cancer on the individual and the family and strategies for helping.

In 2009 we were proud to become approved by the Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners to sponsor Category I Continuing Education programs after successfully meeting the Board's requirements for authorization. It is our hope to continue to be a resource to our fellow oncology support professionals as we invite them into our community. It has definitely broadened the referral base for our services and our programs have received accolades from attendees.




**Moving Programs to the Barn** Realizing the many details that are involved in moving our programs from the house to the barn, we worked as a team to develop

a plan to make this transition as smooth as possible. In preparation, we "piloted" several programs in the barn.

The first move was our Kids Circle group followed by our Qigong program. This was followed by scheduling two Sunday Mindfulness Meditation series and our Diving Deeper into Yoga Class in the barn. Now everyone wants to be in the barn! It is our expectation that all of the Mind, Body, Spirit classes will have taken up residence in the barn's second floor meditation studio by spring of 2011.

We have also utilized the barn space increasingly to host both professional and lay gatherings of people who wish to learn more about HopeWell. It is a magnificent structure that draws so much interest—an instant "ice-breaker" for any social interaction!
